



Welcome to the off-road cycle trail at Campbell Park. Each lap of the trail is 2.5 km through the meadows and sections of shady woodland. Mostly short grass, there are also gravel and woodchip surfaces to tackle. The trail is not too technical although there are some steep gradients and riders will climb 85m per lap!

Code of Conduct:

- Make sure your bike is in good working order and suitable for the trail. Helmets should be worn at all times.
- The trail is one-way, only ride in the marked direction and keep to the marked trail.
- Riders ahead of you have right of way. Warn others of your approach in plenty of time.
- The trail occasionally crosses leisure routes - give way to pedestrians and other cyclists.
- Stop for horseriders & be aware of grazing sheep.
- The woodland areas may be gated when sheep are on site (usually Jan - Mar).
- The trail is intended for informal riding. If you wish to arrange a formal event please contact The Parks Trust.
- Riders use the trail at their own risk. In an emergency call 999. The address of this site is Campbell Park, Silbury Boulevard, Milton Keynes, MK9 4AD (the cricket pavilion).
