Getting to the event:

Public Transport

Bus

- There are bus stops around the outside of Campbell Park as shown on this map
- Connections are via the City Centre

MK Train Station is located to the west of the park, approximately 1.4 miles and 30 minutes walking.



Getting to the event: Private transport

- Parking at Campbell Park is very limited
- Please use City Centre car parks and enter the park via the route shown with the pink arrow (right).
- Event organisers may offer a **limited amount of blue badge parking** on site, or drop-off areas. Please check event webpage for information.
- If you are coming by taxi, direct the driver to drop you at Milton Keynes Gallery, MK9 3QA and enter the park via the route shown with the pink arrow (right).

- Your event will likely be held in both or one of these places:
 - Amphitheatre (shown in purple)
 - Events Plateau

Welcome

- Every event is different, but we want everyone to feel welcome in our parks.
- Please speak with us or with the event organiser about any accessibility requirements you may have.
- Please check ahead for accessibility information, which may include:
 - BSL interpretation
 - Hearing loop system
 - Quiet/calm spaces
 - Accessible seating
 - Accessibility aware staff



Event facilities

- A Changing Places toilet is available at Milton Keynes Gallery during open times. Please check <u>their website</u>.
- Temporary accessible toilets will be provided by event organisers on-site.
- There is no café in Campbell Park. Many events will provide refreshment options.




Moving around the event

- Wayfinding with vary between event organisers. If you are unsure of where to go, or would benefit from an event map, speak to the event organiser.
- Parks Trust events will have wayfinding signs where possible.
- The Event Plateau is flat and level and has a surfaced perimeter path. Grass is wheelchair accessible when it is dry.
- The Amphitheatre has steep, terraced seating traversed by stairs. Stairs do not have handrails. Event organisers may situate accessible viewing areas at the top or bottom of the amphitheatre, both of which can be accessed via step-free routes.



Parks Trust Events

- We host our own events in Campbell Park
- A typical Parks Trust event will take place at the Events Plateau (pictured)
- Step-free access is shown by the blue dashed line (right).
- Parking is at City Centre car parks
- There is step-free access to the Events Plateau from the City Centre or Avebury Boulevard
- There will be accessible toilets where required
- Changing Places toilet is available at MK Gallery
- Campbell Park is a wide area with lots of quiet spaces to escape the bustle of a large event
- We will promote any specific accessibility services on the event webpage.





Help and support

- At Parks Trust events, accessibility-aware staff and volunteers can help you.
- Look out for purple uniforms and ask for assistance.
- Additional accessible information will be displayed on our Parks Trust van.
